Preparatory activities (if applicable): the activities involved more than 30 participants.

Location / Dates: Rome, between February 2021 and June 2022

Short description: These activities consisted of frequent online meetings involving all consortium partners to discuss the organization of events, project content and proposals for both, implementation activities and future developments.

Events:

Three events were realised within the framework of this project:

Event 1

Participation:

The event involved 53 citizens, including 32 participants from the city of Rome (**Italy**), 21 participants from the cities of Blagoevgrad (**Bulgaria**), Prague (**Czech Republic**), Riga (**Latvia**), Barcelona (**Spain**), Novo Mesto (**Slovenia**), Warsaw (**Poland**), Tallinn (**Estonia**), Athens (**Greece**), Berlin (**Germany**), Eisenstadt (**Austria**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Rome (**Italy**), from 03/06/2021 to 05/06/2021.

Short description: The objective of the event was the launch of the project and the presentation of the Escape room model in order to test it and work out together the topics and functioning by looking at the partners' proposals and evaluations.

Event 2

Participation: The event involved 1193 citizens, including 156 participants from the city of Bratislava (**Slovakia**), 172 participants from the city of Athens (**Greece**), 101 participants from the city of Tallinn (**Estonia**), 110 participants from the city of Blagoevgrad (**Bulgaria**), 134 participants from the city of Warsaw (**Poland**), 107 participants from the cities of Prague, Sedlcany and Uvaly (**Czech Republic**), 102 participants from the city of Riga (**Latvia**), 117 participants from the cities of Berlin and Zittau (**Germany**), 97 participants from the city of Rome (**Italy**), 97 participants from the city of Novo Mesto (**Slovenia**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Bratislava (**Slovakia**) from 06/07/2021 to 06/07/2021, in Athens (**Greece**) from 22/11/2021 to 25/11/2021, in Tallinn (**Estonia**) from 21/03/2022 to 21/03/2022, Blagoevgrad (**Bulgaria**) from 01/04/2022 to 03/04/2022, in Warsaw (**Poland**) from 25/04/2022 to 29/04/2022, in Prague, Sedlcany and Uvaly (**Czech Republic**) from 08/04/2022 to 16/06/2022, in Riga (**Latvia**) from 21/04/2022 to 06/05/2022, in Berlin and Zittau (**Germany**) from 25/03/2022 to 09/06/2022, in Rome (**Italy**) from 06/06/2022 to 08/06/2022, in Novo Mesto (**Slovenia**) from 01/06/2022 to 18/06/2022.

Short description: The aim of the event was to organise local escape room implementation activities in all the countries involved.

Event 3

Participation: The event involved 63 citizens, including 40 participants from the city of Novo Mesto (**Slovenia**), 23 participants from the cities of Blagoevgrad (**Bulgaria**), Prague (**Czech Republic**), Riga (**Latvia**), Barcelona (**Spain**), Rome (**Italy**), Warsaw (**Poland**), Tallinn (**Estonia**), Athens (**Greece**), Berlin (**Germany**), Eisenstadt (**Austria**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Novo Mesto (**Slovenia**), from 20/06/2022 to 22/06/2022.

Short description: The objective of the event was the presentation of the final results of the project implementation and the elaboration of a common strategy and proposals for the future development of the escape room training format.
