<p>Description of the activity implemented:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>"EU LEARN" - Preparatory Phase</u> (Nov. 2018 – Jan. 2019)</p> <p>This phase included the following meetings in three different High schools in Rome:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>“From the Ventotene Manifesto to Europe today”</i> - a story of the main stages of the European project (2 hours - 1 meeting per school); 2. <i>“The main European institutions”</i> - a description of the institutional architecture of the European Union (2 hours - 1 meeting per school). <p style="text-align: center;"><u>"EU REFLECT" - Reflection Phase</u> (Dec. 2018 – May 2019)</p> <p>A reflection on EU value and political priorities. This phase started with a plenary session developed in each of the three participating schools. After the topic "European Union’s Unfinished Democracy" has been selected for the prosecution of the project in the EP elections perspective. Proceeded with various meetings of three different working groups (WG): PROSECUTION - DEFENCE – JURY. (6- 18 h each participant -1 plenary meeting + 2/5 group meetings for each WG (TOT 14 meetings).</p>

"ACT" – Communication and Outreach Activities Making of – Phase (16/05/2019)

Students have been tasked with publicly express, as part of a simulated trial, their analyses and proposals on EU future challenges and opportunities. This phase was structured as follows:

1. A public conference structured according our "Europe on Trial" mock trial format;
2. Presentation of the results of a survey carried out in the schools involved.

The "Europe on Trial" format, in April 2019, has been selected by Eu institutions as finalist for the "Altiero Spinelli Price for Outreach".

Outcomes:

- N. of students involved: 65
- N. of local meetings: 21
- Development of a **Report on the perceptions on EU pros and cons** collected among students in the "Reflect" phase
- **Realization of a survey on the perception of the EU** promoted by young people
- Realization of a public **final simulation event "Europe on Trial"** (Full report publication)
