The LADDER Project (DEAR) and Consortium (led by ALDA) deal with the role of Local Authorities in enhancing the awareness on sustainability as a means to development.

Without sustainability there is no development, but mere growth, which might nevertheless endanger the longrun balance of the society and environment.

One of the working groups of the project is focused on Public Private Cooperation in Development and Job Creation. Resource scarcity and the increasing complexity of problems require a coordinated effort by both private companies and Local Authorities to foster development.

This, in turn, requires skills, capabilities, strategic views, effective power, extraordinary commitment. The workshop is meant to provide a contribution to the debate and concrete implementation of sustainable policies within ENI Cbc Med, whose management authority is the Sardinia Region, in particular as concerns tourism as a potential driver of PPC and sustainability.
